Full training and supervision will be given, and shift hours can be flexible between 8am and 6pm. The role offers the opportunity to gain experience in university recruitment and contribute directly to the OU's mission of opening up education to all.

- Make outbound calls to recent OU applicants to encourage conversion to registration by providing information and answering questions about studying psychology at the OU.
- Accurately record call outcomes on telephony system.
- Complete mandatory compliance training on Data Protection Information Security Awareness, Equality Essentials, Health & Safety at Work and Safeguarding.
- Demonstrate a strong commitment to the principles and practice of equality, diversity, and inclusion.
